

Lalomanu Library - Request for Financial Donations

Six year old Clea Soledad Salavert Wykes was on holiday in Samoa when she became one of the many victims of the 29 September 2009 tsunami. Clea loved reading, and in memory of their child, her parents Trudie Wykes and Jorge Salavert are encouraging people to contribute funds for the building of a library at Lalomanu, a small village which bore the brunt of the tsunami, close to where Clea perished.

The Lalomanu Primary School has around 150 students and does not have a library. The short-to-medium term objective of the project is to raise sufficient funds for the construction of a school library, the purchase of the basic necessary furniture and amenities and stocking the library. The long-term objective of the project is to provide additional books on an annual basis, by replacing those damaged or lost and adding new titles for the benefit of the children of Lalomanu.
