## **Early Entry at University of Wollongong**

- Opens 1 July, closes 1 September

- Students can apply for Early Entry for up to 5 degrees at UOW.
- B.Psychology is now available (but not B.Arts Psychology and B.Science Psychology)
- B.Education (PDHPE) is now available
- Year 10, year 11 and mid year 12 results are requested for the online application. The mid year 12 results can be exam mark or otherwise assessment mark as per half-year report. This prevents delays in completing the application due to absence of trial results. Many faculties will request that students bring trial results to the interview.
