- Science
 Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Earth and Environmental science
- Mathematics
 Specialist, Methods, General, Essential
- English
 Literature, English, English as an Additional language, Essential
- History
 Modern, Ancient

The consultation website (www.australiancurriculum.edu.au) is available for everyone to read, review, download or print the draft K-10 and 11-12 curriculum. It will also be the place where individuals and groups can provide feedback and where the on-line feedback survey can be completed.

Format of the sessions will be:
 Introduction and overview
 Break up into separate course groups for feedback
 Plenary – report back from each group

Forum participants will be expected to review the drafts (11-12 and 9-10) that are published on-line prior to attending the session and consider the following broad questions:

- Do the draft content descriptions represent what all young Australians should learn in this curriculum area?
- Are the content descriptions clear in relation to what should be taught and what students are expected to learn?
