

PAKISTAN FLOOD EMERGENCY APPEAL

The floods began in late July and since then:

- **Over 20 million people have been displaced.** This is over one tenth of the population and more than were displaced in Haiti, the Boxing Day Tsunami and the 2005 South Asia Earthquake combined.
- **700,000 homes have been destroyed.** Over one fifth of the total land area has been inundated.
- **Over 1,600 people are dead**, and more are likely as the risk for water born diseases increase, and food and clean water supplies decrease. Furthermore, in a region of political instability the floods have further exacerbated the problems of governance in Pakistan.
- **Only one quarter of the \$459 million urgently needed for emergency response has been received.** Media and humanitarian aid has been minimal compared to that for the disasters previously listed.
