

RADFORD COLLEGIANS' ASSOCIATION COMMUNITY OUTREACH SERVICE AWARD

The Radford Collegians' Association was established in 1989 to represent former students of Radford College. All former students are eligible for membership of the Association. A small committee meets quarterly to foster relations between former students and the College community, and to provide strategic assistance for reunions of former students.

The Community Outreach Service Award is an annual award, of up to \$6 000 in total, awarded to three graduating Year 12 students who plan to undertake community outreach service following their graduation from Radford College. There is no requirement to have undertaken community service work previously.

The Radford Collegians' Association is seeking applications from the Class of 2010 in order to award this year's grants. The Collegians are looking to award the grant to students looking for a challenge.

To apply, submit a two page application to Kate Potter at kalbob@hotmail.com by Friday 10 September 2010.

While your application should include a short paragraph on the proposed community project, it should primarily focus on clearly outlining the challenges you expect to face, your reasons for undertaking the project, and your goals and expectations upon completing the project.

The grants are not be awarded on the merits of the project itself.

The application should itemise how the funds provided by the Collegians may be used. Acceptable uses of the grant include programs costs, airfares, accommodation costs or as a donation towards the charity you are working with to fund a specific aspect of the project you are involved with, eg sporting goods. The grant should not be put towards personal expenses such as food or similar.

Plans for the intended community work need not have been finalised, but you must demonstrate that you have a viable project. Please ensure that you have made contact with the organisers and list the intended dates that you will be working on the project. Successful applicants will be expected to provide written confirmation by 30 September 2011 that they will be undertaking the project.

Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed by the Collegians Committee. Please provide your phone and e-mail contact details in your application, so that we are able to contact you. Interviews are expected to take place during the week beginning 13 September 2010.

If successful, applicants are expected to provide a written report of their experience of at least one page detailing the project and how the grant money was allocated. This may be included in College publications, such as the Radford Report.
